Polling Dates and Venues for Election of Regional Youths Representatives to Parliament, 2026

In line with Article 61(2) of the Constitution of the Republic of Uganda, the Electoral Commission appointed the dates and venues below for the elections of Regional Youths Representatives to Parliament:

1.	Regional Conference for Election of Regional Youths Representatives to Parliament	Eastern Region	Islamic University in Uganda – Mbale City	28 th January 2026
2.	Regional Conference for Election of Regional Youths Representatives to Parliament	Central Region	Masaka Sports Arena - Kitovu-Masaka City	28 th January 2026
3.	Regional Conference for Election of Regional Youths Representatives to Parliament	Northern Region	Mvara Secondary School, Arua City	28 th January 2026
4.	Regional Conference for Election of Regional Youths Representatives to Parliament	Western Region	Ntare School, Mbarara City	28 th January 2026

The Delegates' Conference for the election of the Regional Youth Representative to Parliament shall comprise the following:

1. Three (3) members of each Sub County/Town/Municipal Division Youth Executive Committee in the Region (Chairperson; Secretary for Finance and the Secretary for Female Affairs)
2. The nine (9) members of each City/District Youth Executive Committee in the Region;
3. Three (3) members of each Municipality/City Division Youth Executive Committee in the Region (Chairperson; Secretary for Finance and the Secretary for Female Affairs)
4. One (1) Youth with Disability (PWD) per city/district in the Region;
5. Two (2) delegates of the Uganda National Students Association (UNSA) per City/District in the Region, one of whom must be female.

All candidates, their agents and supporters are reminded to observe the respective dates and venues and participate in accordance with the guidelines for the elections.
